THANK YOU - ILAN P. Where do I sign the title of my vehicle: You sign on the back of the title, in the First Reassignment section, to the left on line 9. The required signature is under the section "All owners shown on the front of this title, who are releasing their interest must sign. For more about the donation/signing over the title visit Oregon DMV infomation. You can also sign the Bill of Sale and then notify the Oregon DMV within 10 days. Also you may want to record the odometer reading on the title, if it is applicable. I'm the registered owner but I can't find my title: If you bought a vehicle but the title is lost, you may be able to get a title replacement and transfer the title to your name in one transaction with the DMV by filling out the Application for Replacement Title (Form 735-226). If there was a lien on the title from a bank or other financial institution you will also need a lien release from the bank stating the loan has been paid off and releasing the lien on the vehicle. Please note that DMV can issue a replacement title only if the title is lost, destroyed, or damaged. We work with a title processing agency that can mail you the necessary forms title transfer if needed. If you would like us to take care of the duplicate title process for you so that you won't have to interact with the DMV we will be able to pickup your car providing that you can complete one of the following options. For vehicles less than 10 model years: We will need two copies of the Oregon Secure Powers of Attorney, signed by all owners listed on the title (one to apply for the duplicate title and one to sign the duplicate title when it is received from the DMV). The Oregon Secure POA is a 4-part form, so please provide us with 2 of the 4 copies and a Lien release, if applicable. or An Application for Replacement Title signed by all owners on listed on the title. Oregon Secure Power of Attorney, signed by all owners listed on the title. Lien release, if applicable. For vehicles 10 or more model years: A Power of Attorney (secure or generic) signed by all owners listed on the title and a Lien Release if need be. The owner of the vehicle is deceased: The estate is not being probated, A transfer can be accomplished by the surviving spouse and/or heirs. We require a notarized Inheritance Affidavit signed by each heir listing the person who is awarded the vehicle, a properly signed title by the person named in the Inheritance Affidavit, and a lien release, if applicable. In the case of a deceased owner whose estate is being probated, we require a copy of the court-issued Letter of Testamentary appointing the personal representative of the estate, a properly signed title by the personal representative, and a lien release, if applicable. The vehicle was abandoned on my property: In most cases we can still pick up your vehicle, if we need paperwork from you it will be in the form of your signature on a short document describing the location where the vehicle was left and your request for us to remove it. If you are not able to attain a negotiable title or the paperwork for a duplicate title, the vehicle can be sold with lien papers through Oregon's Lien Sale process. If the vehicle remains unclaimed after the appropriate timeline has elapsed (30 days for vehicle valued at \$2500 or less or 60 days for vehicles valued at over \$2500), we are then legally able to sell the vehicle on behalf of the Provider. We require written notification on Provider letterhead requesting the Lien Sale process. This process should be used as a last resort when all efforts have failed to produce a negotiable title. More resources on title transfers in Oregon: If you bought a vehicle but the title is lost, you may be able to get a title replacement and transfer the title to your name in one transaction with DMV. A title replacement and transfer may be completed in one transaction if: The vehicle is not subject to odometer requirements; or If one current registered owner will be remaining on the title For more on transferring the title go to www.oregon.gov - The Oregon DMV bill of sale form is a written register of the technicalities involved in an exchange of a vehicle for a monetary value. The document specifies key factors within the process, such as info on individuals and the vehicle. The form is authenticated within the document via endorsements of the concerned parties. The state of Oregon does not necessarily stipulate that a bill of sale be presented to obtain title and registration, but it does provide evidence of ownership, which is obligated to do so. Arrive at your closest Oregon DMV Branch with the following filings in hand: A prepared and filled-out Oregon Application for Title and Registration (Form 735-226), Manufacturer's Certificate of Origin (for new vehicles) or the title to the vehicle signed-over including signatures and accurate odometer statement, whichever applies. Completed bill of sale with all corresponding endorsements, as well as buyer, seller, vehicle, and purchase information. Lien Release if the title contains any liens posted within the document. Certified VIN Inspection, which can be secured at your local police office. If you reside within a DEQ region, you are mandated to procure a Certificate of Emissions Test available in several test methods. Payment for Title, Registration, and license plate fees. Step 1 – Download in Adobe PDF. Step 2 – Vehicle Description – Include in the space provided in the first segment of the form, the following information applies to the vehicle being transferred: Plate Number Year Make Vehicle Identification Number Title Number Step 3 – Buyer Information – Within the next portion of the form, the data pertaining to the buyer should be indicated in the boxes: Name of Buyer (Last, First, Middle) Date of Purchase Buyer's Address Step 4 – Seller(s) Information and Signature(s) – The last section of the form is allocated to the information on the seller or sellers of the vehicle: Printed Name of Seller(s) Signature of Seller(s) Date of Release This rule specifies the documents DMV will consider primary ownership documents for the purposes of perfecting a security interest in a vehicle. Except as provided in section (3) of this rule, a primary ownership document is: A manufacturer's certificate of origin (MCO) or equivalent document as described in OAR 735-022-0030 (Manufacturer's Certificate of Origin (MCO) Definitions) through 735-022-0060 (Documents Equivalent to Manufacturer's Certificate of Origin (MCO)). This subsection applies to: A vehicle or camper built by a manufacturer that has never been titled or registered; and A vehicle or camper built, assembled, or reconstructed using a component kit that has never been titled or registered. The MCO may only be considered a primary ownership document for the vehicle or camper parts contained in the kit. A current certificate of title or salvage title issued for a vehicle or camper, or A Certificate to Obtain Title for a Vehicle (U.S. Government Form SF 97), for a vehicle or camper previously owned by the U.S. Government and where interest is being transferred. Notwithstanding section (2) of this rule, DMV may, at its discretion, consider other documents to be primary ownership documents when: DMV is satisfied that the original Oregon title has been lost or destroyed, and that there has been a change in interest; Interest has been transferred by operation of law under Oregon law, or through court action in a court having jurisdiction over persons or property located in Oregon, and the primary ownership documents described in section (2) of this rule are not available; The security interest is in a vehicle or camper not manufactured for sale in the U.S., and that is not currently registered or titled in the U.S.; The security interest is in a vehicle or camper last titled or registered outside the U.S.; or DMV is satisfied that a primary ownership document described in section (2) of this rule was never issued, is not obtainable, or has been surrendered to another jurisdiction. Documents DMV may determine are primary ownership documents under section (3) of this rule include but are not limited to: A court judgment or decree from a court having jurisdiction over persons or property located in Oregon that awards ownership of a vehicle or camper as a matter of law. A certificate of possessory lien foreclosure as described in OAR 735-020-0012 (Application for Title by Possessory Lien Foreclosure); A completed and signed Inheritance Affidavit (DMV Form 735-516) vesting the interest of a deceased owner in the person designated by all the heirs as the owner of the vehicle or camper; A completed and signed Certificate of Ownership of an Assembled Light Trailer or Heavy Trailer (DMV Form 735-6644) for a trailer built by someone other than a manufacturer; A completed and signed Application for Replacement Title (DMV Form 735-515) or Application for Replacement Salvage Title (DMV Form 735-230) where: The application is accompanied by an Application for Title and Registration (DMV Form 735-226) that includes a release of interest from anyone listed on the original title that will not be listed on the new title; and Any change in interest is of a type not subject to odometer disclosure requirements under ORS 803.102 (Odometer disclosure statement upon transfer of interest) and OAR 735-028-0000 (Definitions Relating to Odometer Disclosures and Voluntary Odometer Readings) through 735-028-0100 (Expedited Title Services); A completed and signed Certification of Ownership Facts (DMV Form 735-550); An Ownership document issued by the U.S. Armed Forces for a vehicle or camper owned by a member of the U.S. Armed Forces; A salvage title, salvage bill of sale, or, except as provided in section (12) of this rule, a dismantler (wrecker) bill of sale on a vehicle or camper whose title has been surrendered to a jurisdiction; or For a vehicle or camper described under subsections (3)(c) and (d) of this rule: A certificate for export purposes issued by a foreign jurisdiction; or A vehicle or camper registered in a jurisdiction if the vehicle has been registered but is not currently titled. When the application for notation of a security interest is for a vehicle or camper that is initially being titled as assembled, reconstructed, or a vehicle replica, the primary ownership document must be specific to the frame or unibody. When the application for notation of a security interest is for a vehicle or camper manufactured in more than one stage, the primary ownership document(s) must cover each stage of manufacture. DMV may invalidate a primary ownership document as evidence of ownership if it determines: The document is fraudulent or contains false information; or The document does not show the most current ownership interest in the vehicle or camper. If, after a title has been issued, it is determined that the evidence of ownership is invalid under section (7) of this rule, DMV may cancel the vehicle title. Before a title is cancelled, DMV will send a notice of the proposed cancellation to the vehicle owner or lessee, security interest holder(s) and lessor (if applicable), as listed in DMV records. A cancellation becomes effective 10 days after the date the notice is deposited with the postal service, unless a hearing is requested within that 10-day period. If a timely hearing is requested, the cancellation will be contingent on the outcome of the hearing. A title cancellation under section (8) of this rule automatically invalidates the security interest(s) noted on that title. A new application for notation for perfection of security interest and valid evidence of ownership must be submitted to DMV before security interest in a vehicle can be perfected pursuant to ORS 803.097 (Perfection of security interest in vehicle). DMV will not invalidate a primary ownership document as evidence of ownership based solely on missing title requirements (e.g., missing odometer information, and fees). A document considered by DMV to be a primary ownership document under section (3) of this rule constitutes proof of ownership for purposes of ORS 803.205 (Proof of ownership or security interest on transfer or application for title or registration).
